Please do join in by ringing hand bells at your door. You may also want to light a candle and place it in a window or show some other symbol of light in a dark world.

Virtual Advent Calendar - Sadly this year, due to COVID restrictions, we are unable to let our Posada travel to the homes of the families in our Parish. However, we have a new and exciting idea! We are going to produce a virtual Advent Calendar. We would like families to get involved and to illustrate a different part of the Christmas story. These creations will then be added to the website, one a day, during December. It's as close as we can get to opening a communal advent calendar door each day. If you would like to take part, we will give you a particular bible verse to share with your child or children. We then need the budding young artists in your house to produce some artistic creation that illustrates your verse - this could be a collage, a drawing, a painting, a tableau involving dolls and other toys around the house, or even a freeze frame photo of your family enacting the verse. The more creative the better! You then need to take a photo of the creation and send it to Beccy, we will post a different verse, picture and photograph each day for the followers of our website all through Advent.
